Apart from UCSI and the nation's five research universities, no other Malaysian institution made the top 500 benchmark<sup>1</sup>.

The University also enjoys the distinction of being a top 100 university in the world for performing arts<sup>2</sup>. It also made history when it was acknowledged as Asia's fastest rising university<sup>3</sup>. It is also rated in Tier 5 (Emerging Universities) in Malaysia's SETARA 2017 exercise, placing it on a par with renowned foreign branch campuses.
